What is Public Works

- ▶ According to the American Public Works Association, Public Works is the combination of physical assets, management practices, policies, and personnel necessary for government to provide and sustain structures and services essential to the welfare and acceptable quality of life for its citizens.
- ► Level Of Service (LOS) Level of service is a determined work standard that is obtainable and sustainable to perform the work. The higher the LOS, the higher the cost; therefore, the more tax revenue needed to sustain the staff and construction cost. This means higher taxation to sustain the high level of service.




Funding Sources

- Local Maintenance Improvement Grant (LMIG)
 - For road maintenance only in Town owned Rights-of-way
 - 70/30 grant from GDOT
 - Based on miles of road owned by the Town
 - Approximately \$120,000 per year
- State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP)
 - Local Assistance Program (LAP)
 - 80/20 grant from GDOT
 - Applies to higher volume roads in the Town that meet certain GDOT classifications. Can also apply to Local Community Imitative (LCI) projects
 - Recently completed: Tyrone Road Upcoming: Dogwood Trail
- SPLOST and General Fund
 - Used for Capital Improvement Projects (CIP) and general maintenance. Recent SPLOST CIP's - Briarwood Rd & Farr Rd

What is PCI and why do we care?

- ▶ Pavement Condition Index (PCI):
 - ▶ Based on type of road distress, area and severity of the distress a value is assigned to the road section
 - Some examples of distress are Alligator Cracking, Shoving, Rutting, Longitudinal Cracking, and Traverse Cracking
 - ► This is performed by a third-party inspection service









Traffic Calming is primarily handled in two ways: passive or physical. Physical measures include speed humps/tables, circles, chicanes and other methods that cause a vehicle to slow down without losing line of sight or safety. Passive measures such as signage and radar signs are used to gain attention and remind drivers to drive safely.

Signage and striping

- MUTCD Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices is the standard reference used in many states. It has specific Warrants for determine the appropriateness of signs and their placement.
- Reflectivity is a safety issue. The Town's new signage and striping meets high reflectivity standards to improve safety. Signage and striping is evaluated by the Town at night to determine which signs or stripes need to be replaced.
- Question: On a residential road there is a T intersection with a road that ends in a cul-de-sac. People are speeding on the road and a property owner wants stop signs at the intersection to make the cars slow down and stop. Is this a good way to reduce speed?
 - No. The MUTCD specifically states that stops signs should not be used to control speed on roads.




Which Stop sign is most visible at night?







Sewerage System


- 1. Funded by the Sewer Enterprise Fund and by SPLOST.
- 2. Sewage is collected in a gravity system that flows to one of the five lift stations in town. Coweta County WASA assists the Town with maintenance and operations of the lift stations. From the lift stations, sewage is eventually pumped to the Fulton County and then to Camp Creek wastewater treatment facility for treatment and discharge.
- 3. The Town purchases capacity from Fulton County and Fairburn. This capacity limits the Town to how much sewer service it can provide. Capacity purchase is very expensive and takes a long time to acquire.
- 4. The sewer line that runs from your home to the edge of your property is called a service line. The service line is the property owner's responsibility to maintain.













Sewer Rates

- Sewer Rates are based off the amount of water you use as determined by the water meter provided by Fayette County Water System.
- ► Even though water is not always going down your drain into the system such as filling a swimming pool or a leak, that does not change your rate calculation with the Town.
- Sewer Rates will increase in proportion to the Town's sewer rate increase by Fulton County.



How to reduce your sewer bill to the Town

- Make sure you do not have leaks. Dripping faucets and leaking toilets can increase your bill.
- Use low flow toilets, showers, and sink aerators.
- Do not over water your lawns. Over watering your grass will increase your water and sewer bills and may cause fungus and other issues with your grass.
- ► Talk with your water supplier about the cost of putting your irrigation system on a separate meter. This does not always save you money unless you water a lot.







Sewer Maintenance Costs

- Sewer costs goes up quickly when you have clogs in your system. You own the sewer service line going from your home/business to the Town's right-of-way. Often fats, oils and grease (FOG) can collect in your line and choke down your flow until it clogs.
- ▶ In addition, tree and shrub roots get into the system. Roots catch FOG and solids until it clogs the line.
- Wipes are another major problem with clogs. If you need to use packaged wipes, make sure they are flushable. If not, the wipes will remain strong and do not give way in your plumbing. These wipes can also clog lift station pumps which costs tens of thousands of dollars. This additional cost could mean increases to your rates.






