

## **ADDENDUM NUMBER 2**

### **SHAMROCK PAVILION A/V DESIGN & INSTALL**

**PROJECT NUMBER: TYR-2026-01**

The following changes, modifications, and/or clarifications to the project documents or a part, thereof, and change the original documents only in the manner and to the extent stated.

1. Rear projection is requested because front projection to a screen located along the back wall is expected to have poor visibility from the lawn/audience area. The electrical plans show projector power routed to a location approximately 6 feet from the rear wall. Please refer to Addendum 1 for additional projection details.
2. The referenced "20' screen" dimension is intended to mean approximately 20 feet diagonal. The Town has not selected an aspect ratio and will rely on the proposer's professional recommendation for an appropriate aspect ratio based on typical movie-night and presentation use.
3. The Town is open to a permanently installed screen and a front-projection approach only if the proposer can demonstrate:
  - o adequate viewing angle and visibility from the audience area, and
  - o the screen and projector placement do not detract from or conflict with the pavilion's architecture.
4. The Town is not interested in a permanent LED video wall/screen as an alternate to projection.
5. The Town's reference to a "protected area" for the projector means the projector shall be located/installed under the roof structure in a manner that is protected from tampering or interference from below.
6. The Town expects the contractor to mount fixtures in a manner that minimizes visual clutter and compliments the pavilion.
7. Direct truss mounting is assumed to produce the lowest visual impact. If direct fixture mounting to the existing trusses is not feasible or otherwise interferes with architectural elements, the contractor shall furnish and install a horizontal light bar/pipe between trusses for fixture mounting.
8. The intended rack/enclosure location is the area near the electrical panels at the rear of the structure
9. The Town has not established a maximum footprint for rack/enclosure equipment; however, the proposer shall prioritized reduced visual impact where feasible.
10. The Town intends to have active internet service at the pavilion at the time of installation; however, the A/V system shall retain basic operation if internet service is unavailable or interrupted.
11. Bluetooth connectivity shall be implemented with password-protected pairing so that only owner-authorized devices can pair/connect.
12. The pricing language in statement D (page 7) is intended to direct proposers to the Fee Proposal Form and it's requested cost categories. Supporting budget documentation that further details the costs within those categories is welcome.
13. The Town DOES desire assistive listening systems to be included in proposals. A Revised Fee Proposal Form including this item as a category will be issued with this addendum and posted with the RFP.
